- 1 (2) intentionally or knowingly benefits from
 2 participating in a venture that involves an activity described by

- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 5 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 6 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 7 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and 8 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 9 purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the 10 11 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs before the effective date. 12
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
