- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 43.05, Penal Code, is amended to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Sec. 43.05. COMPELLING PROSTITUTION. (a) A person commits
- 7 an offense if the person [he] knowingly:
- 8 (1) causes another by force, threat, or fraud to
- 9 commit prostitution; or
- 10 (2) causes by any means a person younger than $18 [\frac{17}{1}]$
- 11 years to commit prostitution, regardless of whether the actor knew
- the age of the person at the time the offense was committed.
- (b) An offense under <u>Subsection (a)(1)</u> [this section] is a
- 14 felony of the second degree. An offense under Subsection (a)(2) is a
- 15 felony of the first degree.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 20 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For the
- 21 purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the
- 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense is
- 23 committed before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
