- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Chapter 104, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended 5 by adding Section 104.07 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 104.07. POSTING OF CERTAIN NOTICES REQUIRED. (a) The 7
- 8 holder of a permit or license under Chapter 25, 26, 28, 32, 69, or
- 71, other than the holder of a food and beverage certificate shall 9
- display a sign containing the following notice in English and in 10
- 11 Spanish:

- 12 NOTICE ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING: Obtaining forced labor or
- 13 services is a crime under Texas law. If you or someone you know is a
- 14 victim of such a crime, you are encouraged to call the national
- human trafficking hotline at 1-888-373-7888. You may remain 15
- 16 anonymous.
- (b) The sign must be at least 8-1/2 inches high and 11 inches 17
- 18 wide and displayed in a conspicuous manner clearly visible to the
- public and employees of the permit or license holder. The English 19
- notice must cover approximately two-thirds of the sign, and the 20
- 21 Spanish notice must cover approximately one-third of the sign.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
