- A political subdivision, one purpose of which is to 7 supply fresh water for domestic or commercial use or to furnish 8 sanitary sewer services, roadways, or drainage, may not be created 9
- in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality unless the 10
- governing body of the municipality gives its written consent by 11

- 13 Water Code. In giving its consent, the municipality may not place
- 14 any conditions or other restrictions on the creation of the
- political subdivision other than those expressly permitted by 15

- SECTION 2. Section 54.016, Water Code, is amended by adding 17 Subsection (i) to read as follows: 18

- 2 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 3 date the land was added, and the former law is continued in effect
- 4 for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
