1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the use of certain state money for costs related to the
1-11 relocation to this state of the Interstate Oil and Gas Compact
1-12 Commission, for the support of that commission, and for related
1-13 economic development.

1-14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-15 SECTION 1. Section 40.152, Natural Resources Code, is
1-16 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-17 (d) Notwithstanding Section 40.151 and Subsection (a) of
1-18 this section, if the Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission
1-19 relocates to this state on or before December 31, 2008, money in the
1-20 fund may be disbursed to pay for costs related to the relocation,
1-21 for the support of that commission, and for related economic
1-22 development. The amount of money in the fund that may be disbursed
1-23 under this subsection in a state fiscal year may not exceed
1-24 \$500,000. Sections 40.153 and 40.161 do not apply to money
1-25 disbursed under this subsection. This subsection expires August
1-26 31, 2009.

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
