A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the billing and reassignment of the professional 3 component of diagnostic imaging services.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 3, Occupations Code, is 6 amended by adding Chapter 114 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 114. DIRECT BILLING OF DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING SERVICES
- 8 Sec. 114.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 9 (1) "Diagnostic imaging services" means magnetic resonance

 10 imaging, computed tomography, positron emission tomography, and

 11 any hybrid technologies combining any of these or other imaging
- 12 modalities.

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- 13 (2) "Professional component of diagnostic imaging services"
- 14 means the component of a medical imaging procedure that involves an
- interpretation to be performed by a health care provider, such as
- 16 the interpretation of a radiograph or the images produced by
- 17 diagnostic imaging services, and includes valuation for the
- 18 physician work, practice expense, and medical liability associated
- 19 with the interpretation of a diagnostic imaging service.
- 20 (3) "Patient" means a person who receives a physical
- 21 examination, evaluation, diagnosis, or treatment by a health care
- 22 provider.
- 23 (4) "Health care provider" means any person licensed as a
- 24 health care professional or authorized to practice in health care

1 under Subtitles B and C, Title 3.

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- 2 (5) "Imaging center" means any facility or office other than 3 a hospital that performs a diagnostic imaging service.
- (6) "Licensing authority" means the department, board,

 office, or other agency of the state that regulates a health care

 provider who is subject to this chapter.
- 7 (7) "Professional interpretation of a diagnostic image"
 8 means the official interpretation documented by written report that
 9 is attached to a patient's permanent record and signed by the
 10 physician rendering the interpretation.
- 11 (8) "Referral" means a request or order by a health care
 12 provider for diagnostic imaging services for a patient.
 - (9) "Single specialty physician group" means a physician group practice that receives at least seventy-five percent of its revenues in any consecutive twelve-month period from members of the group who belong to a single medical specialty.
- 17 (10) "Technical component of diagnostic imaging services"

 18 means the component of a medical imaging procedure that involves

 19 the actual taking or performance of the diagnostic imaging service.
- Section 114.002. DIRECT BILLING OF DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING

 SERVICES. (a) A health care provider, located in this state or in

 another state, providing the professional component of diagnostic

 imaging services for a patient in this state shall present or cause

 to be presented a claim, bill or demand for payment for those

 services only to the following:
- 26 (1) The patient directly;
- 27 (2) The responsible insurer or other third party payor

- 1 for the patient;
- 2 (3) A public health clinic or non-profit health clinic
- 3 ordering such services when such clinic is exempt from federal
- 4 income tax and is organized and operated under Section 501 of the
- 5 Internal Revenue Code; or
- 6 (4) A governmental agency and/or its specified public
- 7 or private agent, agency or organization on behalf of the recipient
- 8 of the services.
- 9 (b) No health care provider shall, directly or indirectly,
- 10 charge, bill, or otherwise solicit payment for the professional
- 11 <u>interpretation of a diagnostic image unless such service was</u>
- 12 rendered personally by the health care provider.
- 13 (c) An imaging center or hospital shall present or cause to
- 14 be presented a claim, bill, or demand for payment for diagnostic
- imaging services only if such claim, bill or demand for payment is
- 16 <u>limited to the technical component of the diagnostic imaging</u>
- 17 service.
- (d) A health care provider who is a member of a single
- 19 specialty physician group that generates diagnostic images and who
- 20 orders a professional interpretation of those diagnostic images for
- 21 <u>a patient shall not, directly or indirectly, receive any</u>
- 22 professional fee, profit or revenue in payment for such
- 23 professional interpretation if the health care provider does not
- 24 personally perform the professional interpretation of the images
- 25 for such patient.
- (e) No patient, insurer, third party payor, hospital,
- 27 public health clinic, or non-profit health clinic shall be required

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- 1 to reimburse any health care provider for charges or claims
- 2 submitted in violation of this section.
- 3 Section 114.003. DISCIPLINARY ACTION. A licensing authority
- 4 having jurisdiction over any health care provider who may request
- 5 or provide diagnostic imaging services may revoke, suspend or deny
- 6 the renewal of the license of any health care provider who violates
- 7 the provisions of this chapter.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 114.002, Occupations Code, as added by
- 9 this Act, applies only to conduct that occurs on or after the
- 10 effective date of this Act. Conduct that occurs before the
- 11 effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
- 12 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
