(a) A person may not represent that a head of cattle the person is offering for sale is sound for breeding purposes unless a person who holds a license to practice veterinary medicine issued under Chapter 801, Occupations Code, or a person under the supervision of a license holder has determined through a physical examination that the animal is sound for breeding purposes.
- (b) A person who violates Subsection (a) commits an offense.
 An offense under this subsection is a Class C misdemeanor.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
