- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 1601, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1601.508 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1601.508. REQUIRED HAIR CARE PRODUCT. The following
- 8 persons are responsible for providing on-site at the person's shop
- 9 or school, as appropriate, a product that combines water, Luvimer,
- 10 Si-Tec DMC, and Cellosize PCG-10 to reverse damage to hair caused by
- 11 chemical processing:

- 13 permit issued under this chapter and performs a barbering service
- 14 described by Section 1601.002(1)(A), (B), (C), (H), or (I); and
- 15 (2) the owner or manager of a barbershop, specialty

- SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 1601.353, Occupations
- 18 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) The department may not approve an application for a
- 20 permit for a barber school that provides training leading to
- 21 issuance of a Class A barber certificate unless the school has:
- 22 (1) an adequate school site housed in a substantial

- 6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act to Subsection
- 7 (a), Section 1601.353, Occupations Code, applies only to an
- 8 application for the issuance or renewal of a barber school permit
- 9 that is made on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 10 application made before the effective date of this Act is covered by
- 11 the law in effect when the application was made, and the former law
- is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
