H.B. No. 3409

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to staff development training for certain public school personnel regarding student disciplinary procedures.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 37.0181 to read as follows:

Sec. 37.0181. STAFF DEVELOPMENT FOR CERTAIN EDUCATORS. (a) A principal or other appropriate administrator who oversees student discipline shall attend staff development training designed to assist the principal or administrator in determining methods for incorporating appropriate discipline management techniques consistent with the student code of conduct adopted under Section 37.001 by the school district employing the principal or administrator.

(b) Staff development training under this section must include:

(1) specific information relating to appropriate methods for applying the provisions of this chapter; and

(2) information relating to the distinction between a discipline management technique used at the principal's discretion under Section 37.002(a) and the discretionary authority of a teacher to remove a disruptive student under Section 37.002(b).

(c) Staff development training under this section must comply with Sections 21.451(a), (b), and (c).

1 (d) Staff development training under this section is in
2 addition to any staff development training required under Section
3 21.451.

4 (e) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
5 implement this section.

6 SECTION 2. Section 21.453(a), Education Code, is amended to
7 read as follows:

8 (a) The staff development account is an account in the
9 general revenue fund. The account consists of gifts, grants,
10 donations, appropriations for the purpose of staff development
11 under this subchapter and Section 37.0181, and any other money
12 transferred by law to the account. Funds in the account may be used
13 only as provided by this section.

14 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
15 school year.

16 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
