A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the punishment for tampering with or fabricating
- 3 physical evidence.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Jennifer Cave Act.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 37.09, Penal Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (e), an [An] offense
- 10 under Subsection (a) or Subsection (d)(1) is a felony of the third
- 11 degree. An offense under Subsection (d)(2) is a Class A
- 12 misdemeanor.
- (e) An offense under Subsection (a)(1) is a felony of the
- 14 first degree if the physical evidence that is altered, destroyed,
- or concealed is human remains.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 18 Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 20 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For the
- 21 purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the
- 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 23 committed before that date.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
