## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the application of state school accountability 3 standards to a public school campus that has met adequate yearly progress standards under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 39.051, Education Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows: 7 8 (d-1) The commissioner shall define unacceptable performance for the academic excellence indicator under Subsection 9 (b)(1) in a manner that excludes a campus that has met adequate 10 11 yearly progress standards adopted by the commissioner as required 12 by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (Pub. L. No. 107-110) but has otherwise failed to satisfy state performance standards under that 13 14 indicator solely on the basis of the campus's performance on an assessment instrument administered under Section 39.023 in 15 mathematics, reading, or English language arts. 16 SECTION 2. Section 39.072, Education Code, is amended by 17 18 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: (e) A campus that has met adequate yearly progress standards 19 adopted by the commissioner as required by the No Child Left Behind 20 21 Act of 2001 (Pub. L. No. 107-110) may not receive a performance rating of academically unacceptable if the rating is based solely 22 23 on the failure of the campus to satisfy state performance standards 24 under Section 39.051(b)(1) on an assessment instrument

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1	administered under Section 39.023 in mathematics, reading, or
2	English language arts.
3	SECTION 3. Section 39.1322, Education Code, is amended by
4	adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
5	(e) A campus may receive technical assistance as provided by
6	this section if the campus has met adequate yearly progress
7	standards adopted by the commissioner as required by the No Child
8	Left Behind Act of 2001 (Pub. L. No. 107-110) but for the current
9	school year has failed to satisfy state performance standards under
10	Section 39.051(b)(1) on an assessment instrument administered
11	under Section 39.023 in mathematics, reading, or English language
12	<u>arts.</u>
13	SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
14	school year.
15	SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
16	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
17	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
18	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
19	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
