2 SECTION 2. Section 41.0052(a), Election Code, is amended to 3 read as follows:

4 (a) The governing body of a political subdivision other than
5 a county may, not later than December 31, <u>2007</u> [2005], change the
6 date on which it holds its general election for officers to another
7 authorized uniform election date.

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
