A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to coordination of postsecondary curricula and to an 3 academic planning Internet website to support academic progress by students enrolled at public institutions of higher education. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Sections 61.0764 and 61.0765 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 61.0764. COORDINATION OF CURRICULA AT TWO-YEAR 8 INSTITUTIONS AND GENERAL ACADEMIC TEACHING INSTITUTIONS. (a) In 9 this section, "two-year institution of higher education" means a 10 public junior college, public state college, or public technical 11 12 institute. (b) The board shall collaborate with general academic 13 14 teaching institutions and two-year institutions of higher education to: 15 16 (1) compare the curricula of the general academic teaching institutions with the curricula of the two-year 17 18 institutions of higher education to determine if the curricula of the two-year institutions of higher education satisfy the goals of: 19 (A) providing the prerequisite courses needed 20 21 for students to enroll in courses at general academic teaching 22 institutions; 23 (B) providing courses that will be generally 24 accepted for course credit by general academic teaching

2	(C) preparing students for academic success at
3	general academic teaching institutions; and
4	(2) ensure that the curricula of two-year institutions
5	of higher education satisfy the goals described by Subdivision (1),
6	and adopt any standards necessary for curricula and instruction at
7	two-year institutions of higher education and any plans necessary
8	to implement the standards.
9	(c) Each two-year institution of higher education shall
10	designate in the institution's student course catalog each course
11	that is not generally accepted for course credit by general
12	academic teaching institutions.
13	Sec. 61.0765. ACADEMIC PLANNING WEBSITE. (a) In this
14	section, "two-year institution of higher education" has the meaning
15	assigned by Section 61.0764.
16	(b) The board shall maintain an Internet website that
17	includes:
18	(1) an enrollment guide for use by a student enrolled
19	in a two-year institution of higher education or general academic
20	teaching institution for planning and tracking the student's
21	progress toward completion of the student's degree or certificate
22	program;
23	(2) information concerning the recommended core
24	curriculum developed under Section 61.822, including information
25	describing courses included in the recommended core curriculum and
26	describing the core curriculum transfer provisions provided by that
27	section;

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(3) information concerning major and minor areas of 1 2 study available at institutions of higher education; and 3 (4) any other information the board determines would 4 serve students enrolled at institutions of higher education in developing and implementing academic plans and making academic 5 6 progress. (c) Each institution of higher education shall, on the 7 primary admissions information page on the institution's Internet 8 website, provide a link to the board's Internet website maintained 9 10 under Subsection (b). SECTION 2. The student course catalog of each two-year 11 institution of higher education must satisfy the requirements of 12 Section 61.0764(c), Education Code, as added by this Act, beginning 13 with the 2009 fall semester. 14 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 19

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
