4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 533, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 533.0073 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 533.0073. THREE-PARTY INTEGRATED MODEL OF
8	CARE. (a) The commission may, if cost-effective and feasible,
9	develop and implement a three-party integrated model of care to
10	fully integrate services under the state Medicaid program with
11	services under the Medicare program for individuals dually eligible
12	for Medicare and Medicaid. The three parties participating in the
13	model of care are the commission, the Centers for Medicare and
14	Medicaid Services, and a managed care organization.
15	(b) The three-party integrated model of care must be
16	designed to:
17	(1) improve the quality, coordination, and
18	cost-effectiveness of services and the management of care for
19	persons described by Subsection (a); and
20	(2) integrate the financing of those services.
21	(c) The commission may implement the three-party integrated
22	model of care in areas of the state with existing Medicaid managed
23	care programs, including a Medicaid Star+Plus pilot program,
24	through and in a manner that is coordinated with the existing

- 2 (d) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 3 <u>Services Commission shall:</u>
- 4 (1) seek approval for any waivers necessary to
- 5 <u>implement a three-party integrated model of care; and</u>
- 6 (2) adopt rules prescribing eligibility requirements
- 7 to participate in the model of care, program benefits, and provider
- 8 <u>requirements.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
