5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 1551.221, Insurance Code, as added by
7	Chapter 178, Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005,
8	is amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection $(d-1)$
9	to read as follows:
10	(d) The board of trustees may <u>:</u>
11	(1) purchase the supplemental health coverage in
12	accordance with Sections 1551.213-1551.216 <u>;</u>
13	(2) offer the coverage through an entity that is not an
14	eligible carrier but that is authorized to offer health insurance;
15	or
16	(3) $[-, or_{r}]$ if the board of trustees determines that it
17	would be cost-effective, [may] provide the supplemental health
18	coverage directly from the employees life, accident, and health
19	insurance benefits fund in accordance with Sections
20	1551.208-1551.212.
21	(d-1) If the board of trustees enters into a contract under
22	Subsection (d), the board may determine that the Employees
23	Retirement System of Texas or any other entity may be named
24	policyholder.

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SECTION 2. Section 1551.221, Insurance Code, as added by
Chapter 899, Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005,
is repealed.

4 SECTION 3. In implementing the voluntary supplemental health coverage program under Section 1551.221, Insurance Code, as 5 6 amended by this Act, the board of trustees of the Employees Retirement System of Texas may enter into a contract based on a 7 8 request for proposal before the effective date of this Act. An 9 entity seeking to contract with the system under the program is not required to resubmit a proposal if the entity submitted a proposal 10 before the effective date of this Act in response to the request for 11 proposal by the board of trustees. This section expires September 12 1, 2008. 13

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
