- 8 executive administrator shall carry out the program for topographic

- 10 (b) The executive administrator shall operate as part of the

- 12 program to acquire, store, and distribute digital, geospatial

- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 16, Water Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Sections 16.023 and 16.024 to read as follows:
- Sec. 16.023. STRATEGIC MAPPING ACCOUNT. (a) The strategic
- 17 mapping account is an account in the general revenue fund. The
- 18 <u>account consists of:</u>
- (1) money directly appropriated to the board;
- 20 (2) money transferred by the board from other funds

- 22 (3) money from gifts or grants from the United States
- 23 government, state, regional, or local governments, educational

5	(b) The account may be appropriated only to the board to:

- 1 INFORMATION PROJECTS. (a) A political subdivision seeking a grant
- 2 under Section 16.023 must file an application with the board.
- 3 (b) An application must be filed in the manner and form
- 4 required by board rules.
- 5 (c) In reviewing an application by a political subdivision
- 6 for a grant, the board shall consider:
- 7 (1) the degree to which the political subdivision has
- 8 used other available resources to finance the development, use, and
- 9 dissemination of digital, geospatial information;
- 10 (2) the willingness and ability of the political
- 11 <u>subdivision to develop</u>, use, and disseminate digital, geospatial

- 13 (3) the benefits that will be gained by making the

- 15 (d) The board may approve a grant to a political subdivision
