4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 118.011(a), Local Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) A county clerk shall collect the following fees for
8	services rendered to any person:
9	(1) Personal Property Records Filing (Sec. 118.012):
10	for the first page
11	for each additional page or part of a page on which
12	there are visible marks of any kind\$4.00
13	(2) Real Property Records Filing (Sec. 118.013):
14	for the first page \$ <u>6.00</u> [5.00]
15	for each additional page or part of a page on which
16	there are visible marks of any kind\$4.00
17	for all or part of each 8-1/2" X 14" attachment or
18	rider \$ 4.00
19	for each name in excess of five names that has to
20	be indexed in all records in which the document must be
21	indexed
22	(3) Certified Papers (Sec. 118.014):
23	for the clerk's certificate\$5.00
24	plus a fee for each page or part of a page \$ 1.00

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1 (4) Noncertified Papers (Sec. 118.0145): 2 for each page or part of a page \$ 1.00 3 (5) Birth or Death Certificate (Sec. 4 118.015) same as state registrar 5 (6) Bond Approval (Sec. 118.016) \$ 3.00 6 (7) Marriage License (Sec. 118.018) \$30.00 7 (8) Declaration of Informal Marriage (Sec. 8 118.019) (9) Brand Registration (Sec. 118.020) \$ 5.00 9 (10) Oath Administration (Sec. 118.021) \$ 1.00 10 SECTION 2. Section 118.013(a), Local Government Code, is 11 amended to read as follows: 12 The fee for "Real Property Records Filing" under Section 13 (a) 14 118.011 is for filing and recording, including indexing, in the 15 real property records in the office of the county clerk a document that is authorized or required to be filed in those records, except 16 17 that the county treasurer shall remit to the comptroller, in the manner provided by Subchapter B, Chapter 133, \$0.95 of the fee 18 19 collected for filing and recording the first page of each document for deposit to the credit of the strategic mapping account 20 21 established under Section 16.024, Water Code. SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 16, Water Code, is amended 22 by adding Sections 16.023, 16.024, and 16.025 to read as follows: 23

24 <u>Sec. 16.023. STRATEGIC MAPPING PROGRAM.</u> The executive 25 <u>administrator shall develop and implement as part of the Texas</u> 26 <u>Natural Resources Information System a strategic mapping program to</u> 27 acquire, store, and distribute digital, geospatial information.

1	Sec. 16.024. STRATEGIC MAPPING ACCOUNT. (a) The strategic
2	mapping account is an account in the general revenue fund. The
3	account consists of:
4	(1) money deposited to the credit of the account under
5	Section 118.013, Local Government Code;
6	(2) money directly appropriated to the board;
7	(3) money transferred by the board from other funds
8	available to the board;
9	(4) money from gifts or grants from the United States
10	government, state, regional, or local governments, educational
11	institutions, private sources, or other sources;
12	(5) proceeds from the sale of maps, data,
13	publications, and other items; and
14	(6) interest earned on the investment of money in the
15	account and depository interest allocable to the account.
16	(b) The account may be appropriated only to the board to:
17	(1) develop, administer, and implement the strategic
18	<pre>mapping program;</pre>
19	(2) provide grants to political subdivisions for
20	projects related to the development, use, and dissemination of
21	digital, geospatial information; and
22	(3) administer, implement, and operate other programs
23	of the Texas Natural Resources Information System, including:
24	(A) the operation of a Texas-Mexico border region
25	information center for the purpose of implementing Section 16.021
26	<u>(e)(5);</u>
27	(B) the acquisition, storage, and distribution

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1	of historical maps, photographs, and paper map products;
2	(C) the maintenance and enhancement of
3	information technology; and
4	(D) the production, storage, and distribution of
5	other digital base maps, as determined by the executive
6	administrator or a state agency that is a member of the Texas
7	Geographic Information Council.
8	(c) The board may invest, reinvest, and direct the
9	investment of any available money in the fund as provided by law for
10	the investment of money under Section 404.024, Government Code.
11	Sec. 16.025. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR DIGITAL, GEOSPATIAL
12	INFORMATION PROJECTS. (a) A political subdivision seeking a grant
13	under Section 16.024 must file an application with the board.
14	(b) An application must be filed in the manner and form
15	required by board rules.
16	(c) In reviewing an application by a political subdivision
17	for a grant, the board shall consider:
18	(1) the degree to which the political subdivision has
19	used other available resources to finance the development, use, and
20	dissemination of digital, geospatial information;
21	(2) the willingness and ability of the political
22	subdivision to develop, use, and disseminate digital, geospatial
23	information; and
24	(3) the benefits that will be gained by making the
25	grant.
26	(d) The board may approve a grant to a political subdivision
27	only if the board finds that:

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1	(1) the grant will supplement rather than replace
2	money of the political subdivision;
3	(2) the public interest is served by providing the
4	grant; and
5	(3) the grant will further the state's ability to
6	gather, develop, use, and disseminate digital, geospatial
7	information.
8	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
