5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 26, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 26.047 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 26.047. TERM LIMITS IN POPULOUS MUNICIPALITIES.
8	(a) This section applies only to a municipality with a population
9	of 1.8 million or more.
10	(b) In this section:
11	(1) "Governing body of a municipality" includes the
12	mayor of the municipality.
13	(2) "Municipal term limit" means a provision in a
14	municipal charter or ordinance that imposes a limit on the number of
15	terms or otherwise restricts the length of service a member of the
16	governing body of a municipality may serve on the governing body.
17	(c) The governing body of the municipality shall decide
18	whether an election held under this section will authorize term
19	limits for members of the governing body of the municipality

(d) The mayor of a municipality shall order an election in

(1) three four-year terms; or

(2) six two-year terms.

- 4 (e) The ballot at the election must be printed to permit
- 5 voting for or against the proposition: "Authorizing term limits

- 9 (f) If a majority of the votes received at the election
- 10 favor the proposition, the number and length of terms a person may
- 11 serve on the governing body is limited as provided in the
- 12 proposition. The municipality shall adjust the length of the terms
- of the members of the governing body as necessary to comply with the
- 14 proposition.
- 15 (g) If less than a majority of the votes received at the
- 16 <u>election favor the proposition, municipal term limits and the</u>
- 17 length of the terms of the members of the governing body that
- 18 existed before the election are not affected.
- 19 (h) In applying a term limit authorized by this section:
- 20 (1) a term to which a member of the governing body was
- 21 elected or appointed before the election held under Subsection (d)
- 22 <u>is counted only if the member served one-half or more of the term;</u>

- 24 (2) a partial term to which a member of the governing
- 25 body is elected or appointed on or after the date of the election
- 26 held under Subsection (d) is counted only if the member serves
- one-half or more of the term.
