H.B. No. 3481

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to disclosure and availability of certain information
3 concerning certain officers of regional water planning groups.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 176.001(3) and (4), Local Government
6 Code, are amended to read as follows:

7 (3) "Local governmental entity" means a county,
8 municipality, school district, junior college district, regional
9 water planning group, or other political subdivision of this state
10 or a local government corporation, board, commission, district, or
11 authority to which a member is appointed by the commissioners court
12 of a county, the mayor of a municipality, or the governing body of a
13 municipality. The term does not include an association,
14 corporation, or organization of governmental entities organized to
15 provide to its members education, assistance, products, or services
16 or to represent its members before the legislative, administrative,
17 or judicial branches of the state or federal government.

18 (4) "Local government officer" means:

19 (A) a voting member of the governing body of a
20 local governmental entity; or

21 (B) a director, superintendent, administrator,
22 president, or other person designated as the executive officer of
23 the local governmental entity.

24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
