	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to staff development requirements concerning the
3	instruction of students with disabilities in public schools.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 21.451, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (g) and (h) to read as follows:
7	(g) This subsection applies only to a teacher who provides
8	instruction to a student for whom an individualized education
9	program has been developed under Section 29.005. At least every
10	three years, a teacher to whom this subsection applies is required
11	to complete a minimum number of hours of staff development, as
12	determined by commissioner rule, concerning the instruction of
13	students with disabilities. The staff development must include
14	training relating to:
15	(A) the natures and needs of students with
16	disabilities;
17	(B) methods for providing individualized instruction
18	to and assessing students with disabilities; and
19	(C) <u>behavioral management techniques;</u>
20	(h) <u>The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to</u>
21	administer this section and to create a local option three year
22	implementation schedule. At least one-third of teachers requiring
23	training must participate each year during the implementation
24	period or until all required teachers are initially trained. The

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1	rules must emphasize the need to provide teachers with adequate
2	staff development to enable them to implement individualized
3	education programs for students with disabilities in an effective
4	manner.
5	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2008-2009
6	school year.
7	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
8	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
9	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
10	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
11	Act takes effect September 1, 2008.
