5 SECTION 1. Chapter 104, Civil Practice and Remedies Code,

6 is amended by adding Section 104.0021 to read as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 104.0021.</u> STATE LIABILITY: SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION

DISTRICTS. (a) In a cause of action based on conduct described by

Section 104.002(a), the State Soil and Water Conservation Board

shall indemnify a director of a soil and water conservation

district for actual damages, court costs, and attorney's fees

adjudged against the director without regard to whether the

director performed the director's services for compensation.

(b) For the purposes of Section 104.002(a), an act or

omission by a director of a soil and water conservation district in

the course and scope of the person's position as a director of the

district is considered an act or omission by the director in the

18 course and scope of the person's office, employment, or contractual

19 performance for or service on behalf of the State Soil and Water

20 <u>Conservation Board.</u>

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21 (c) In addition to liability for indemnification under

22 Subsection (a), the State Soil and Water Conservation Board shall

23 indemnify a director of a soil and water conservation district as

24 provided by Section 104.0035. For the purposes of that section, the

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- 1 director of the district is considered a person covered by Section
- 2 104.001.
- 3 (d) The attorney general shall defend a director of a soil
- 4 and water conservation district in a cause of action covered by this
- 5 section. Sections 104.004(b) and (c) apply to representation by
- 6 the attorney general under this subsection.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 108.001(1), Civil Practice and Remedies
- 8 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (1) "Public servant" means a person who is:
- 10 (A) a public official elected or appointed to
- 11 serve a governmental unit and acting in that capacity when the act
- or omission on which the damages were based occurred; or
- 13 (B) covered by Section 104.001, 104.0021, or
- 14 [Section] 102.001.
- 15 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 17 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 19 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 20 that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
