AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of the Texas Commission on Environmental
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Quality to adjust a fee or administrative penalty assessed.

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5.703, Water Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The commission may not reduce a generally applicable fee
- 8 the commission by rule has established for a permit application,
- 9 report, service provided by the commission, or other matter to an
- 10 amount that is less than 25 percent of the established fee unless
- 11 the commission by rule establishes that reduced amount as the new
- 12 generally applicable fee.

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- SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 7, Water Code, is amended
- 14 by adding Section 7.0671 to read as follows:
- 15 <u>Sec. 7.0671. LIMITATION ON</u> AUTHORITY TO REDUCE
- 16 ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. The commission may not reduce an
- 17 administrative penalty the commission has finally assessed against
- 18 <u>a person to an amount that is less than 25 percent of the penalty</u>
- 19 amount assessed, including a reduction of a penalty as otherwise
- 20 <u>authorized by Section 7.067.</u>
- 21 SECTION 3. Sections 5.703(d) and 7.0671, Water Code, as
- 22 added by this Act, apply to any fee or administrative penalty owed
- 23 to the commission on or after the effective date of this Act except
- 24 for a fee or administrative penalty the amount of which has been

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- 1 reduced by an enforceable agreement entered into before the
- 2 effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
