- 8 Sec. 61.0453. DISCHARGE OR RETALIATION FOR COMPLAINTS
- 9 PROHIBITED. The commission may not discharge or in any manner
- 10 discriminate or retaliate against an employee who in good faith
- 11 makes a complaint to the commission or cooperates with the office in
- 12 <u>an investigation</u>.
- Sec. 61.0454. OVERSIGHT OF STUDENTS. (a) At a facility of
- 14 the commission, a single individual may not have complete control,
- 15 supervision, or oversight over the schedule and movements of the
- 16 children in the facility.
- 17 (b) The commission shall by rule establish procedures to
