- 2 relating to designating July 21 as First Lady Frances Cox Henderson
- 3 Remembrance Day.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 662.054 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 662.054. FIRST LADY FRANCES COX HENDERSON REMEMBRANCE
- 8 DAY. (a) July 21 is First Lady Frances Cox Henderson Remembrance Day
- 9 in honor of the life and achievements of Frances Cox Henderson, who
- 10 was the first First Lady of the State of Texas in 1846.
- 11 (b) First Lady Frances Cox Henderson Remembrance Day shall
- be regularly observed by appropriate programs and activities in the
- 13 public schools and other places to properly commemorate her life
- 14 and achievements and to inspire a greater appreciation of the
- 15 history of this state.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
