- 14 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to a case filed with the clerk of a court that has an official court
- 16 reporter on or after the effective date of this Act. A case filed
- 17 with the clerk of the court before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective
- 19 date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 20 purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
