- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 87, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 87.403 to read as follows:
- Sec. 87.403. SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING. (a) The board of
 regents of The Texas A&M University System may establish and
 operate a school of engineering as a professional school of Texas
 A&M University--Corpus Christi.
- 11 (b) In administering the engineering school, the board may

 12 prescribe courses leading to customary degrees offered at other

 13 leading American schools of engineering and may award those

 14 degrees.
- (c) Before the board establishes an engineering school 15 under this section, but not later than June 1, 2008, the Texas 16 17 Higher Education Coordinating Board shall prepare a feasibility study to determine the actions the system must take to obtain 18 accreditation of the engineering school. The Texas Higher 19 Education Coordinating Board shall deliver a copy of the study to 20 the chair of each legislative standing committee or subcommittee 21 22 with jurisdiction over higher education.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
