H.B. No. 3595

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the amount charged by the comptroller for export stamps.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 151.158(g), Tax Code, is amended to read as follows:

(g) The comptroller shall charge 50 cents [~~\$1.60~~] for each stamp. The comptroller shall use the money from the sale of the stamps only for costs related to producing the stamps, including costs of materials, labor, and overhead. Any unspent money shall be deposited to the credit of the general revenue fund. Customs brokers who return unused stamps to the comptroller's office on a quarterly basis shall get credit towards the purchase of new stamps.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
