5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 542, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 542.405 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 542.405. REVENUE FROM CERTAIN TRAFFIC PENALTIES
8	COLLECTED BY A MUNICIPALITY. (a) In this section, "photographic
9	traffic signal enforcement system" means a system that:
10	(1) consists of a camera system and vehicle sensor
11	installed to exclusively work in conjunction with an electrically
12	operated traffic-control signal;
13	(2) is capable of producing one or more recorded
14	photographic or digital images that depict the license plate
15	attached to the front or the rear of a motor vehicle that is not
16	operated in compliance with the instructions of the traffic-control
17	signal; and
18	(3) is designed to enforce compliance with the

- 7 amount equal to 35 percent of all revenue derived from civil or

- 10 SECTION 2. This Act applies to revenue received by a local
- 11 authority unit of this state from the imposition of a civil or
- 12 administrative penalty on or after the effective date of this Act,
- 13 regardless of whether the penalty was imposed before, on, or after
- 14 the effective date of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
