relating to the date on which eligibility for benefits begins under certain programs for governmental employees and retirees.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 1551.1055, Insurance Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 1551.1055. DATE ELIGIBILITY BEGINS[; WAITING PERIOD].

- 8 (a) Notwithstanding any other law [Except as provided by
 9 Subsection (c) or (d)], eligibility under Section 1551.101 begins
 10 on the first day that [of the calendar month that begins after the
 11 90th day after the date] the employee performs services for a state
 12 agency or is qualified for and begins to hold elected or appointed

- 14 (b) Notwithstanding any other law [Except as provided by
 15 Subsection (c)], eligibility under Section 1551.102, for an
 16 individual who does not retire at the end of the last month for
 17 which the individual is on the payroll of a state agency before
 18 retirement, begins on the first day of the calendar month that
 19 begins after [the 90th day after] the date the individual retires.
 - [(c) The waiting period established by Subsections (a) and (b) applies only to the determination of initial eligibility to participate in the group benefits program and does not apply to the determination of initial eligibility to participate in optional and voluntary insurance coverages under the group benefits program.

[(d) This subsection applies only to an employee of an institution of higher education or a dependent of the employee. Notwithstanding Subsection (a), eligibility under Section 1551.101 may not begin earlier than the first day that an employee performs services for an institution of higher education if any amount paid for premium incurred before the date specified under Subsection (a) for the employee and any dependents of the employee is paid from money not appropriated from the general revenue fund, in accordance with policies and procedures established by the governing body of the institution of higher education.]

- 11 SECTION 2. Section 1601.1045, Insurance Code, is amended to 12 read as follows:
- Sec. 1601.1045. DATE ELIGIBILITY BEGINS[+ WAITING PERIOD].
- 14 (a) Notwithstanding any other law [Except as provided by

 15 Subsection (c) or (d)], eligibility under Section 1601.101 begins

 16 on the first day that [of the calendar month that begins after the

 17 90th day after the date] the employee performs services for a

 18 system.
 - (b) Notwithstanding any other law [Except as provided by Subsection (c)], eligibility under Section 1601.102, for an individual who does not retire at the end of the last month for which the individual is on the payroll of a system before retirement, begins on the first day of the calendar month that begins [after the 90th day] after the date the individual retires.
 - (b) applies only to the determination of initial eligibility to participate in the group health benefits program and does not apply

to the determination of initial eligibility to participate in optional coverages under the uniform program.

[(d) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), eligibility under Section 1601.101 may not begin earlier than the first day that an employee performs services for a system if any amount paid for premium incurred before the date specified under Subsection (a) for the employee and any dependents of the employee is paid from money not appropriated from the general revenue fund, in accordance with policies and procedures established by the system.]

SECTION 3. A waiting period that, immediately before the effective date of this Act, is applicable to an individual under Section 1551.1055 or 1601.1045, Insurance Code, as those sections existed before amendment by this Act, terminates on the effective date of this Act.
