9	or a municipality or public health district in the county, shall
10	require a mobile food unit to:
11	(1) return to the food service establishment or
12	commissary from which the unit operates within each 24-hour period
13	that the mobile food unit is in operation to have cleaning and other
14	services performed on the unit; and
15	(2) obtain, on completion of an inspection following
16	servicing, written documentation that the mobile food unit has been
17	serviced daily as required by Subdivision (1).
18	(b) A county, municipality, or public health district that
19	has installed an electronic tagging system, shall:
20	(1) register and record confirmation that the unit has
21	been serviced as required by Subsection (a)(1); and
22	(2) issue a written copy of the confirmation to the
23	mobile food unit for the purpose of documentation under Subsection
24	<u>(a)(2).</u>

This Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 25
