1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to mobile food units in certain populous counties;
1-11 providing a penalty.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Chapter 437, Health and Safety Code, is amended
1-14 by adding Section 437.0074 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 437.0074. MOBILE FOOD UNITS IN CERTAIN POPULOUS
1-16 COUNTIES. (a) A county with a population of at least 2.8 million,
1-17 or a municipality or public health district in the county, shall
1-18 require a mobile food unit to:

1-19 (1) return to the food service establishment or
1-20 commissary from which the unit operates within the 24-hour period
1-21 preceding operation of the mobile food unit to have cleaning and
1-22 other services performed on the unit; and

1-23 (2) obtain, on completion of an inspection following
1-24 servicing, written documentation that the mobile food unit has been
1-25 serviced daily as required by Subdivision (1).

1-26 (b) A county, municipality, or public health district that
1-27 has installed an electronic tagging system shall register and
1-28 record confirmation that the unit has been serviced as required by
1-29 Subsection (a)(1).

1-30 SECTION 2. Section 37.01(2), Penal Code, is amended to read
1-31 as follows:

1-32 (2) "Governmental record" means:

1-33 (A) anything belonging to, received by, or kept
1-34 by government for information, including a court record;

1-35 (B) anything required by law to be kept by others
1-36 for information of government;

1-37 (C) a license, certificate, permit, seal, title,
1-38 letter of patent, or similar document issued by government, by
1-39 another state, or by the United States;

1-40 (D) a standard proof of motor vehicle liability
1-41 insurance form described by Section 601.081, Transportation Code, a
1-42 certificate of an insurance company described by Section 601.083 of
1-43 that code, a document purporting to be such a form or certificate
1-44 that is not issued by an insurer authorized to write motor vehicle
1-45 liability insurance in this state, an electronic submission in a
1-46 form described by Section 502.153(i), Transportation Code, or an
1-47 evidence of financial responsibility described by Section 601.053
1-48 of that code; ~~or~~

1-49 (E) an official ballot or other election record;
1-50 or

1-51 (F) the written documentation a mobile food unit
1-52 is required to obtain under Section 437.0074, Health and Safety
1-53 Code.

1-54 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
