## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the operation of property owners' associations.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 551.0015(a), Government Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(a) A property owners' association is subject to this
7	chapter in the same manner as a governmental body:
8	<u>(1)</u> if:
9	$\overline{\text{(A)}}$ [\frac{(1)}{1}] membership in the property owners'
10	association is mandatory for owners or for a defined class of owners
11	of private real property in a defined geographic area in a county
12	with a population of 2.8 million or more or in a county adjacent to a
13	county with a population of 2.8 million or more;
14	$\underline{\text{(B)}}$ [ $\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}$ ] the property owners' association has
15	the power to make mandatory special assessments for capital
16	improvements or mandatory regular assessments; and
17	$\underline{\text{(C)}}$ [ $\frac{\text{(3)}}{\text{(3)}}$ ] the amount of the mandatory special or
18	regular assessments is or has ever been based in whole or in part on
19	the value at which the state or a local governmental body assesses
20	the property for purposes of ad valorem taxation under Section 20,
21	Article VIII, Texas Constitution; or
22	(2) if the property owners' association:
23	(A) provides maintenance, preservation, and

- 13 SUBJECT TO LAW. A property owners' association is subject to this
- 14 chapter in the same manner as a governmental body:
- 15 <u>(1)</u> if:
- (A)  $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$  membership in the property owners'
- 17 association is mandatory for owners or for a defined class of owners
- 18 of private real property in a defined geographic area in a county
- 19 with a population of 2.8 million or more or in a county adjacent to a

- 21 (B) (B) the property owners' association has

- (C)  $[\frac{(3)}{(3)}]$  the amount of the mandatory special or

- 2 (2) if the property owners' association:
- 3 (A) provides maintenance, preservation, and
- 4 architectural control of residential and commercial property
- 5 within a defined geographic area in a county with a population of
- 6 2.8 million or more or in a county adjacent to a county with a
- 7 population of 2.8 million or more; and
- 8 <u>(B) is a corporation that:</u>
- 9 (i) is governed by a board of trustees who
- 10 employ a general manager to execute the association's bylaws and
- administer the business of the corporation; and
- 12 (ii) does not require membership in the
- 13 corporation by the owners of the property within the defined area.
- SECTION 3. Section 209.005(a), Property Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (a) A property owners' association shall make the books and
- 17 records of the association, including financial records,
- 18 reasonably available to any person requesting access to the books
- or records [an owner] in accordance with Chapter 552, Government
- 20 Code [Section B, Article 2.23, Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act
- 21 (Article 1396-2.23, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes)].
- SECTION 4. Section 209.003(b), Property Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- 24 (b) Except as otherwise provided by this chapter, this
- 25 [This] chapter applies only to a property owners' association that
- 26 requires mandatory membership in the association for all or a
- 27 majority of the owners of residential property within the

- 1 subdivision subject to the association's dedicatory instruments.
- 2 SECTION 5. Chapter 209, Property Code, is amended by adding
- 3 Section 209.0055 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 209.0055. VOTING. (a) In addition to a property
- 5 owners' association described by Section 209.003(b), this section
- 6 applies to a property owners' association that:
- 7 (1) provides maintenance, preservation, and
- 8 architectural control of residential and commercial property
- 9 within a defined geographic area in a county with a population of
- 10 2.8 million or more or in a county adjacent to a county with a
- 11 population of 2.8 million or more; and
- 12 <u>(2) is a corporation that:</u>
- 13 (A) is governed by a board of trustees who employ
- 14 a general manager to execute the association's bylaws and
- administer the business of the corporation; and
- 16 (B) does not require membership in the
- 17 corporation by the owners of the property within the defined area.
- 18 (b) A property owners' association may not bar a property
- 19 owner who does not owe the association any delinquent assessments,
- 20 fees, or fines from voting in an association election solely based
- 21 on the fact that there is a pending enforcement action against the
- 22 property owner.
- SECTION 6. (a) Section 551.0015, Government Code, as
- amended by this Act, applies only to a property owners' association
- 25 meeting that is held on or after September 1, 2007. A property
- owners' association meeting that is held before September 1, 2007,
- 27 is governed by the law in effect at the time the meeting was held,

- 1 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 (b) Section 552.0036, Government Code, as amended by this
- 3 Act, applies only to a request for records or information made to a
- 4 property owners' association on or after September 1, 2007. A
- 5 request for records or information that is made before September 1,
- 6 2007, is governed by the law in effect at the time the request was
- 7 made, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 (c) Section 209.005, Property Code, as amended by this Act,
- 9 applies only to a request for access to records or information made
- 10 to a property owners' association on or after September 1, 2007. A
- 11 request for access to records or information that is made before
- 12 September 1, 2007, is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 13 request was made, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 14 purpose.
- 15 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
