If six-year terms are not permitted under the constitution, directors] serve two-year terms, with as near as 1-17 possible to [the terms of not more than] one-half of the directors' 1-18 terms [directors] expiring on February 1 of each year.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-19 1-20 1-21 1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-23 1-24 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
