- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 54.016 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 54.016. FIXED TUITION RATE FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS.
- 9 (a) In this section:
- 10 (1) "Coordinating board" means the Texas Higher
- 11 Education Coordinating Board.
- 12 (2) "General academic teaching institution" and
- 13 "public junior college" have the meanings assigned by Section
- 14 61.003.
- 15 (b) Except as otherwise provided by this section, in a
- 16 semester or other academic term, the governing board of a general
- 17 <u>academic teaching institution or public junior college may not</u>
- 18 charge tuition to an undergraduate student under Section 54.0513,
- 19 or under any other law granting the institution or college
- 20 <u>discretion to set the tuition rate, at a rate that exceeds the rate</u>
- 21 the institution or college charged the student during the first
- 22 <u>semester or other academic term the student enrolled in the</u>
- 23 institution or college if the student is currently and at all times
- 24 while enrolled at the institution or college has been a resident of

- 1 this state for purposes of Subchapter B or was otherwise entitled to
- 2 pay tuition at the rate provided for residents of this state.
- 3 (c) If a student enrolls in a general academic teaching
- 4 institution after transferring from another public or private
- 5 institution of higher education, Subsection (b) does not apply to
- 6 the student after the second anniversary of the date of that
- 7 enrollment, regardless of whether the student was ever previously
- 8 enrolled at the institution. For any other student enrolled in a
- 9 general academic teaching institution, Subsection (b) does not
- 10 apply to the student after:
- 11 (1) the fourth anniversary of the date the student
- 12 first enrolls at the institution, if the student is enrolled in a
- 13 four-year degree program; or
- 14 (2) the end of the standard completion period for the
- 15 degree program in which the student is enrolled, as established by
- 16 the institution awarding the degree, if the student is enrolled in a
- degree program other than a four-year degree program.
- (d) For a student enrolled in a public junior college,
- 19 Subsection (b) does not apply to the student after the second
- anniversary of the date the student first enrolls at the college.
- 21 (e) Each general academic teaching institution or public
- 22 junior college shall notify each entering undergraduate student,
- 23 <u>including each undergraduate student who transfers to the</u>
- institution or college, of the eligibility requirements for a fixed
- 25 tuition rate under this section.
- 26 (f) In consultation with the general academic teaching
- 27 institutions and public junior colleges, the coordinating board

- 1 shall adopt any rules the coordinating board considers appropriate
- 2 for the administration of this section.
- 3 (g) This section does not apply to a student who enters a
- 4 general academic teaching institution or public junior college for
- 5 the first time before the 2008 fall semester. This subsection
- 6 expires January 1, 2014.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
