- must be a member of the retirement system and must hold a position

- 21 (2) is not with an agency or department with which

- SECTION 2. At the trustee election held by the Employees
 Retirement System of Texas to fill the first vacancy that occurs on
 the board of trustees on or after the effective date of this Act,
 the members and retirees of the retirement system shall elect a
 trustee who meets the eligibility requirements of Section
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
