## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the taking or unloading of fish in this state. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 12.013, Parks and Wildlife Code, 4 is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 12.013. POWER TO TAKE WILDLIFE; FISH. (a) An employee of the department acting within the scope of the 7 employee's authority may possess, take, transport, release, and 8 manage any of the wildlife and fish in this state for investigation, 9 propagation, distribution, education, disease diagnosis 10 or 11 prevention, or scientific purposes. 12 (b) A person who is not an employee of the department who is 13 participating under the supervision of a department employee in a 14 program or event designated by the director as being conducted for research or species propagation and as exempt from the normally 15 applicable size or bag limits may possess, take, transport, or 16 release any fish in this state to accomplish the intent of the 17 18 program or event. SECTION 2. Sections 43.402(a) and (b), Parks and Wildlife 19 Code, are amended to read as follows: 20 21 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) or (c) of this 22 section, no person may engage in fishing in saltwater for sporting purposes in this state, or unload in this state fish or other 23 aquatic life taken for sporting purposes from waters managed by the 24

<u>Gulf of Mexico Fishery Management Council established under the</u> <u>Fishery Conservation and Management Act of 1976 (16 U.S.C. Section</u> <u>1801 et seq.)</u>, unless the person has acquired a saltwater sportfishing stamp <u>endorsement</u> issued to the person by the department. The commission by rule may prescribe requirements relating to possessing a stamp <u>endorsement</u> required by this subchapter.

8 (b) A person who is exempted from obtaining a fishing 9 license under Chapter 46 [<del>of this code</del>] is not required to obtain a 10 saltwater sportfishing stamp <u>endorsement</u>.

SECTION 3. Section 46.001, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 46.001. PROHIBITED ACTS. No person may fish in the 13 public water of this state, or unload in this state fish or other 14 15 aquatic life taken for sporting purposes from waters managed by the 16 Gulf of Mexico Fishery Management Council established under the 17 Fishery Conservation and Management Act of 1976 (16 U.S.C. Section 1801 et seq.), unless he has acquired a fishing license issued under 18 this subchapter, except as provided by Sections 46.0012 and 46.002 19 [of this code]. The commission by rule may prescribe requirements 20 21 relating to possessing a license required by this subchapter. 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
