- (1) "Department" means the Department of Aging and 9
- Disability Services. 10
- (2) "Home and community-based services program" means 11
- 12 the medical assistance waiver program for persons with mental
- 13 retardation and related conditions implemented in accordance with
- 14 Section 1915(c) of the federal Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
- Section 1396n(c)) and administered by the Department of Aging and 15
- 16 Disability Services.
- (b) The department shall establish a pilot program that 17
