1-7 Amend Section 1, as follows:

1-8 SECTION 1. Section 5.053, Water Code, is amended by adding  
1-9 Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-10 (c) Subsection (a)(2) does not apply to an employee of a  
1-11 political subdivision of this state. If the United States  
1-12 Environmental Protection Agency determines that there will be a  
1-13 negative impact on the State of Texas' National Pollution Discharge  
1-14 Elimination Systems delegation, this subsection does not apply.

1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the eligibility of an employee of a political  
1-18 subdivision of this state to be a member of the governing body of  
1-19 certain state agencies.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 5.053, Water Code, is amended by adding  
1-22 Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-23 (c) Subsection (a)(2) does not apply to an employee of a  
1-24 political subdivision of this state.

1-25 SECTION 2. Section 6.053, Water Code, is amended by adding  
1-26 Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-27 (c) Subsection (b)(1) does not apply to an employee of a  
1-28 political subdivision of this state.

1-29 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
