5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter I, Texas Probate Code, is amended by
7	adding Section 11A to read as follows:
8	Sec. 11A. EXEMPTION FROM PROBATE FEES FOR ESTATES OF CERTAIN
9	MILITARY SERVICEMEMBERS. (a) In this section, "combat zone" means
10	an area that the president of the United States by executive order
11	designates for purposes of 26 U.S.C. Section 112 as an area in which
12	armed forces of the United States are or have engaged in combat.
13	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, the clerk of a county
14	court may not charge, or collect from, the estate of a decedent any
15	of the following fees if the decedent died while in active service
16	as a member of the armed forces of the United States in a combat
17	zone:
18	(1) a fee for or associated with the filing of the
19	decedent's will for probate; and
20	(2) a fee for any service rendered by the probate court
21	regarding the administration of the decedent's estate.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
