- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter I, Texas Probate Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 11A to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 11A. EXEMPTION FROM PROBATE FEES FOR ESTATES OF CERTAIN
- 9 MILITARY SERVICEMEMBERS. (a) In this section, "combat zone" means
- 10 an area that the president of the United States by executive order
- 11 <u>designates for purposes of 26 U.S.C. Section 112</u> as an area in which
- 12 armed forces of the United States are or have engaged in combat.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the clerk of a county
- 14 court may not charge, or collect from, the estate of a decedent any
- of the following fees if the decedent died while in active service
- 16 as a member of the armed forces of the United States in a combat
- 17 zone:
- 18 <u>(1) a fee for or associated with the filing of the</u>
- 19 <u>decedent's will for probate; and</u>
- 20 (2) a fee for any service rendered by the probate court
- 21 regarding the administration of the decedent's estate.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
