## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the manner in which notice of certain events concerning
3	the low income housing tax credit program is given.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter DD, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2306.67171 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2306.67171. ELECTRONIC MAIL NOTIFICATION SERVICE. (a)
8	The department shall maintain an electronic mail notification
9	service to which any person in this state may electronically
10	subscribe to receive information concerning the status of
11	preapplications and applications under this subchapter.
12	(b) The electronic mail notification service maintained
13	under Subsection (a) must:
14	(1) allow a subscriber to request for a zip code
15	notification of:
16	(A) the filing of any preapplication or
17	application concerning a development that is or will be located in
18	the zip code;
19	(B) any change in the status of an application or
20	preapplication described by Paragraph (A); and
21	(C) any public hearing to be held concerning an
22	application or preapplication described by Paragraph (A); and
23	(2) respond to a subscriber via electronic mail not
24	later than the later of:

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- 1 (A) the third business day after the date the
- 2 department receives notice of an event described by Subdivision
- 3 (1); or
- 4 (B) if applicable, the date or dates specified by
- 5 Section 2306.6717(a).
- 6 <u>(c) The department may include in an electronic mail</u>
- 7 notification sent to a subscriber any applicable information
- 8 described by Section 2306.6717.
- 9 SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Housing and Community
- 10 Affairs shall have the electronic mail notification service
- 11 required to be maintained under Section 2306.67171, Government
- 12 Code, as added by this Act, fully functional and able to receive
- 13 subscription requests and respond appropriately to those requests
- 14 not later than January 1, 2008.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
