H.B. No. 3796

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to supplemental instruction provided by public school
3 teachers.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
6 amended by adding Section 21.4023 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 21.4023. ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
8 INSTRUCTION. (a) A district shall provide additional compensation
9 to a classroom teacher who voluntarily, but at the direction of the
10 district, provides supplemental instruction to students before or
11 after the regular school day.

12 (b) The additional compensation required by this section
13 must provide an hourly rate of compensation at least equal to the
14 hourly rate received by the classroom teacher through the teacher's
15 regular salary.

16 (c) Any compensation provided under this section is not
17 included in determining whether the district is paying the teacher
18 the minimum monthly salary under Section 21.402.

19 (d) A school district may use funds provided for an
20 intensive program of instruction under Section 28.0213(c) to pay
21 additional compensation required by this section.

22 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a school
23 district may not require a classroom teacher to provide
24 supplemental instruction to a student before or after the regular

1 school day.

2 (f) For purposes of this section, "regular school day" means
3 an eight-hour period each weekday.

4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
5 school year.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
10 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
