- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 54.053, Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 54.053. INFORMATION REQUIRED TO ESTABLISH RESIDENT
- 9 STATUS. A person shall submit the following information to an
- 10 institution of higher education to establish resident status under
- 11 this subchapter:
- 12 (1) if the person applies for resident status under
- 13 Section 54.052(a)(1):
- 14 (A) a statement of the dates and length of time
- 15 the person has resided in this state, as relevant to establish
- 16 resident status under this subchapter; and
- 17 (B) a statement by the person that the person's
- 18 presence in this state for that period was for a purpose of
- 19 establishing and maintaining a domicile;
- 20 (2) if the person applies for resident status under
- 21 Section 54.052(a)(2):
- 22 (A) a statement of the dates and length of time
- 23 any parent of the person has resided in this state, as relevant to
- 24 establish resident status under this subchapter; and

- 1 (B) a statement by the parent or, if the parent is
- 2 unable or unwilling to provide the statement, a statement by the
- 3 person that the parent's presence in this state for that period was
- 4 for a purpose of establishing and maintaining a domicile; or
- 5 (3) if the person applies for resident status under
- 6 Section 54.052(a)(3):
- 7 (A) a statement of the dates and length of time
- 8 the person has resided in this state, as relevant to establish
- 9 resident status under this subchapter; and
- 10 (B) if the person is not a citizen or permanent
- 11 resident of the United States, proof acceptable to the institution
- 12 that the person has submitted to the appropriate federal
- 13 <u>immigration authority a Declaration of Intention</u> [an affidavit
- 14 stating that the person will apply] to become a citizen [permanent
- 15 resident of the United States [as soon as the person becomes
- 16 eligible to apply].
- 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 18 beginning with resident status at public institutions of higher
- 19 education for the 2007 fall semester. Resident status for a
- 20 semester or session before the 2007 fall semester is governed by the
- 21 applicable law in effect before the effective date of this Act, and
- that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
