H.B. No. 3831

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the criteria for selecting a route for a segment of the Trans-Texas Corridor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 227.012, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 227.012. ROUTE SELECTION. (a) The commission shall consider the following criteria when selecting a route for a segment of the Trans-Texas Corridor:

- (1) current and projected traffic patterns;
- (2) the safety of motorists;
- (3) potential risks to persons from spills or accidents of any kind;
- (4) environmental effects, including the effect on air quality;
- (5) current and projected economic development;
- (6) the current and projected need for additional transportation options; and
- (7) system connectivity.

(b) A route for a segment of the Trans-Texas Corridor may not be constructed in a county that is located between the northern border of this state and the northern boundary of a county with a population greater than 430,000 in which no city with a population greater than 83,000 is located until after one or more additional

1 vehicular lanes are added to the portion of an existing highway in
2 that county that is designated as an interstate highway or United
3 States highway.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
