- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 227.012, Transportation Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 227.012. ROUTE SELECTION. (a) The commission shall
- 8 consider the following criteria when selecting a route for a
- 9 segment of the Trans-Texas Corridor:
- 10 (1) current and projected traffic patterns;
- 11 (2) the safety of motorists;
- 12 (3) potential risks to persons from spills or
- 13 accidents of any kind;
- 14 (4) environmental effects, including the effect on air
- 15 quality;
- 16 (5) current and projected economic development;
- 17 (6) the current and projected need for additional
- 18 transportation options; and
- 19 (7) system connectivity.
- 20 (b) A route for a segment of the Trans-Texas Corridor may
- 21 not be constructed in a county that is located between the northern
- 22 border of this state and the northern boundary of a county with a
- population greater than 430,000 in which no city with a population
- 24 greater than 83,000 is located until after one or more additional

- 1 vehicular lanes are added to the portion of an existing highway in
- 2 that county that is designated as an interstate highway or United
- 3 States highway.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
