1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to video equipment on a motor vehicle.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 547.611(a), Transportation Code, is
1-12 amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) A motor vehicle may be equipped with video receiving
1-14 equipment, including a television, a digital video disc player, a
1-15 videocassette player, or similar equipment, only if the equipment
1-16 is located so that the video display is not visible from the
1-17 operator's seat unless the vehicle's transmission is in park or the
1-18 vehicle's parking brake is applied.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
