1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to authorizing the amount of a fee charged by certain
1-10 counties for issuing certain utility certificates.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 232.028(g), Local Government Code, is
1-13 amended to read as follows:

1-14 (g) The commissioners court may impose a fee for a
1-15 certificate issued under this section for a subdivision part of
1-16 which is located in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a
1-17 municipality and part of which is not located in the
1-18 extraterritorial jurisdiction of the municipality. The amount of
1-19 the fee may ~~[not]~~ be the greater of \$30 or ~~[than]~~ the amount of the
1-20 fee imposed by the municipality for a subdivision that is located
1-21 entirely in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the municipality
1-22 for a certificate issued under Section 212.0115. A person who
1-23 obtains a certificate under this section is not required to obtain a
1-24 certificate under Section 212.0115.

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
