21	insurer subject to this subchapter that delivers, issues for
22	delivery, or renews an automobile liability insurance policy in

- 1 reasonable towing expenses and related storage charges assessed in
- 2 relation to a vehicle involved in a motor vehicle accident for which
- 3 <u>an insured under the policy is liable.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an automobile liability
- 5 insurance policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed
- 6 on or after January 1, 2008. A policy delivered, issued for
- 7 delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2008, is governed by the law
- 8 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 9 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
