- SECTION 1. Section 31.127(d), Parks and Wildlife Code, is 5 6 amended to read as follows:
- (d) The operator of a vessel who is involved in a collision, 7 accident, or other casualty that results in death or serious bodily 8 injury to another person and fails to comply with Section 31.104 9
- commits an offense that is a Parks and Wildlife Code felony, except 10
- 11 that if it is shown on the trial of the offense that another person
- 12 died as a result of the collision, accident, or other casualty, the
- maximum term of confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal 13
- 14 Justice is increased to 20 years.

- SECTION 2. Section 550.021(c), Transportation Code, 15 amended to read as follows: 16
- (c) A person commits an offense if the person does not stop 17 or does not comply with the requirements of this section. An 18
- offense under this section: 19
- (1) involving an accident resulting in death of a 20
- 21 person is a felony of the second degree; and
- 22 (2) involving an accident resulting in injury to but
- 23 not death of a person is punishable by:
- 24 (A) [(1)] imprisonment in the [institutional

- 1 division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice for not more
- 2 than five years or confinement in the county jail for not more than
- 3 one year;
- 4 (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ a fine not to exceed \$5,000; or
- 5 (C) $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ both the fine and the imprisonment or
- 6 confinement.
- 7 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 8 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 9 Act. For the purposes of this section, an offense is committed
- 10 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense
- 11 occurs before that date.
- 12 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 13 Act is governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 14 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
