A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the duties of a water service provider in an area served
3	by a municipal sewer service.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 402, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 402.911 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 402.911. DUTIES OF WATER SERVICE PROVIDER TO AN AREA
8	SERVED BY MUNICIPAL SEWER SERVICE. (a) This section applies to ar
9	area only if:
10	(1) a municipality provides sewer service to the area;
11	(2) an entity other than the municipality provides
12	water service to the area; and
13	(3) the municipality provides water service to other
14	<u>areas.</u>
15	(b) A municipality may provide written notice to a person to
16	whom the municipality's sewer service system provides service if
17	the person has failed to pay for the service for more than 90 days.
18	The notice must state the past due amount owed and the deadline by
19	which the past due amount must be paid or the person will lose water
20	service. The notice may be sent by mail or hand-delivered to the
21	location at which the sewer service is provided.
22	(c) The municipality may notify the water service provider
23	of a person who fails to make timely payment after the persor

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receives notice under Subsection (b). The notice must indicate the

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- number of days the person has failed to pay for sewer services and the total amount past due. On receipt of the notice, the water
- 3 service provider shall discontinue water service to the person.
- 4 (d) For each person the water service provider serves in an
- 5 area to which this section applies, the water service provider
- 6 shall provide the municipality with any relevant customer
- 7 information so that the municipality may bill users of the sewer
- 8 service directly and verify the water consumption of users.
- 9 Relevant customer information provided under this section includes
- the name, address, and telephone number of the customer of the water
- 11 service provider, the monthly meter readings of the customer,
- 12 monthly consumption information, including any billing
- 13 adjustments, and certain meter information, such as brand, model,
- 14 age, and location.
- (e) The municipality shall reimburse the water service
- 16 provider for its reasonable and actual incremental costs for
- 17 providing services to the municipality under this section.
- 18 Incremental costs are limited to only those costs that are in
- 19 addition to the water service provider's costs in providing its
- 20 services to its customers, and those costs must be consistent with
- 21 the costs incurred by other water utility providers. The water
- 22 service provider must provide the municipality with documentation
- 23 <u>certified by a certified public accountant of the reasonable and</u>
- 24 <u>actual incremental costs for providing services to the municipality</u>
- 25 under this section.
- 26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
